Sanitation Checklist

Assess your facilities to determine high traffic areas and frequently touched surfaces. Prioritize areas and assign staff members to these for maximum efficiency.

Put on disposable gloves when cleaning and disinfecting. This protects those cleaning and slows the spread of the virus.

If a surface you are disinfecting is dirty, be sure to clean it with soap and water before disinfecting for optimal effectiveness.

Disinfect the surface/object with an EPA-registered household disinfectant. It must contain at least 70% alcohol. If you are unable to access disinfectant, you can create your own by mixing 5 tablespoons bleach per 1 gallon of water or 4 tablespoons of bleach per 1 quart of water.

Dispose of these gloves immediately after use, and do not use them for anything other than cleaning or disinfecting your facilities.
