

Sanitation Checklist

- Assess your facilities to determine high traffic areas and frequently touched surfaces. Prioritize areas and assign staff members to these for maximum efficiency.
- Put on disposable gloves when cleaning and disinfecting. This protects those cleaning and slows the spread of the virus.
- If a surface you are disinfecting is dirty, be sure to clean it with soap and water before disinfecting for optimal effectiveness.
- Disinfect the surface/object with an EPA-registered household disinfectant. It must contain at least 70% alcohol. If you are unable to access disinfectant, you can create your own by mixing 5 tablespoons bleach per 1 gallon of water or 4 tablespoons of bleach per 1 quart of water.
- Dispose of these gloves immediately after use, and do not use them for anything other than cleaning or disinfecting your facilities.
