Preparedness

Response

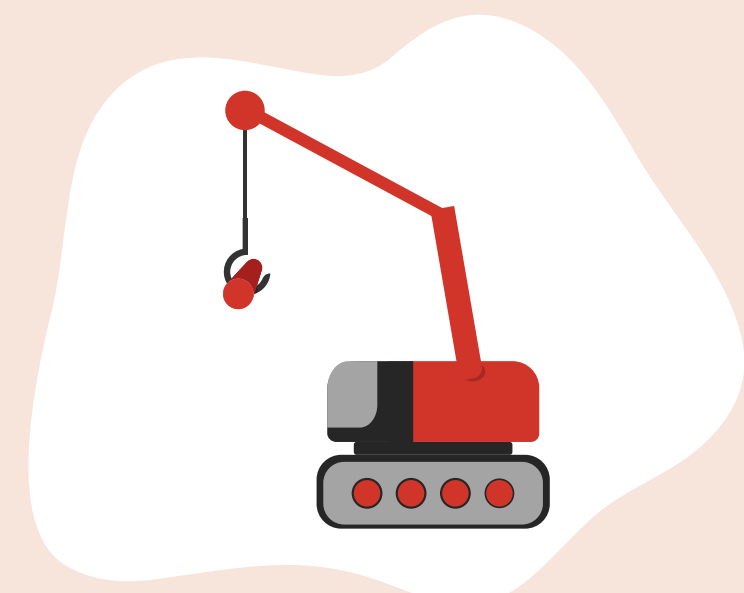
The response phase involves taking action immediately after a disaster occurs.
